PHMS will be sharing campuses with PEC and PHHS as we wait for the new campus construction to be completed.

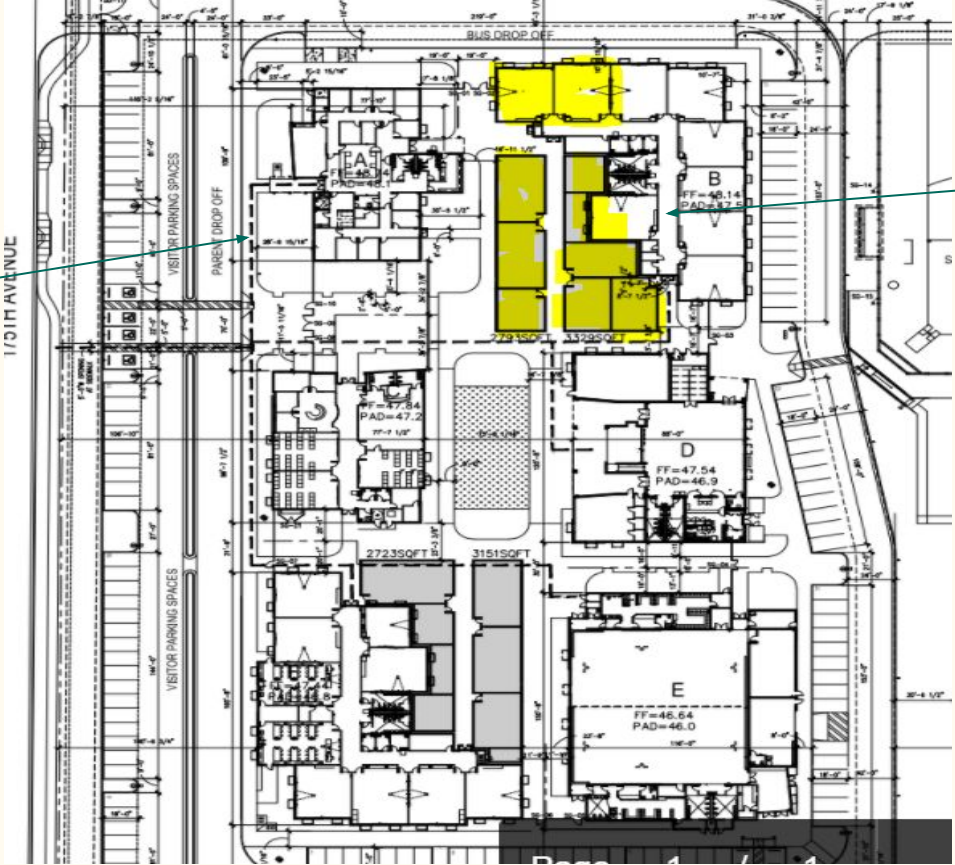
**6th & 7th Grade** will be housed at the PEC campus for first quarter. Locations for classrooms will be the computer labs, library, K-Building, A-Building, C-Building, & E- Building. Elective teachers will travel to students.

**8th Grade** will be housed at the PHHS campus the first quarter. Locations of classroom will be in Building E. Elective teachers will travel to students. Eighth graders will be in the new buildings and on separate schedule from high school students to minimize overlap. Eighth graders will have very limited contact with high school students.

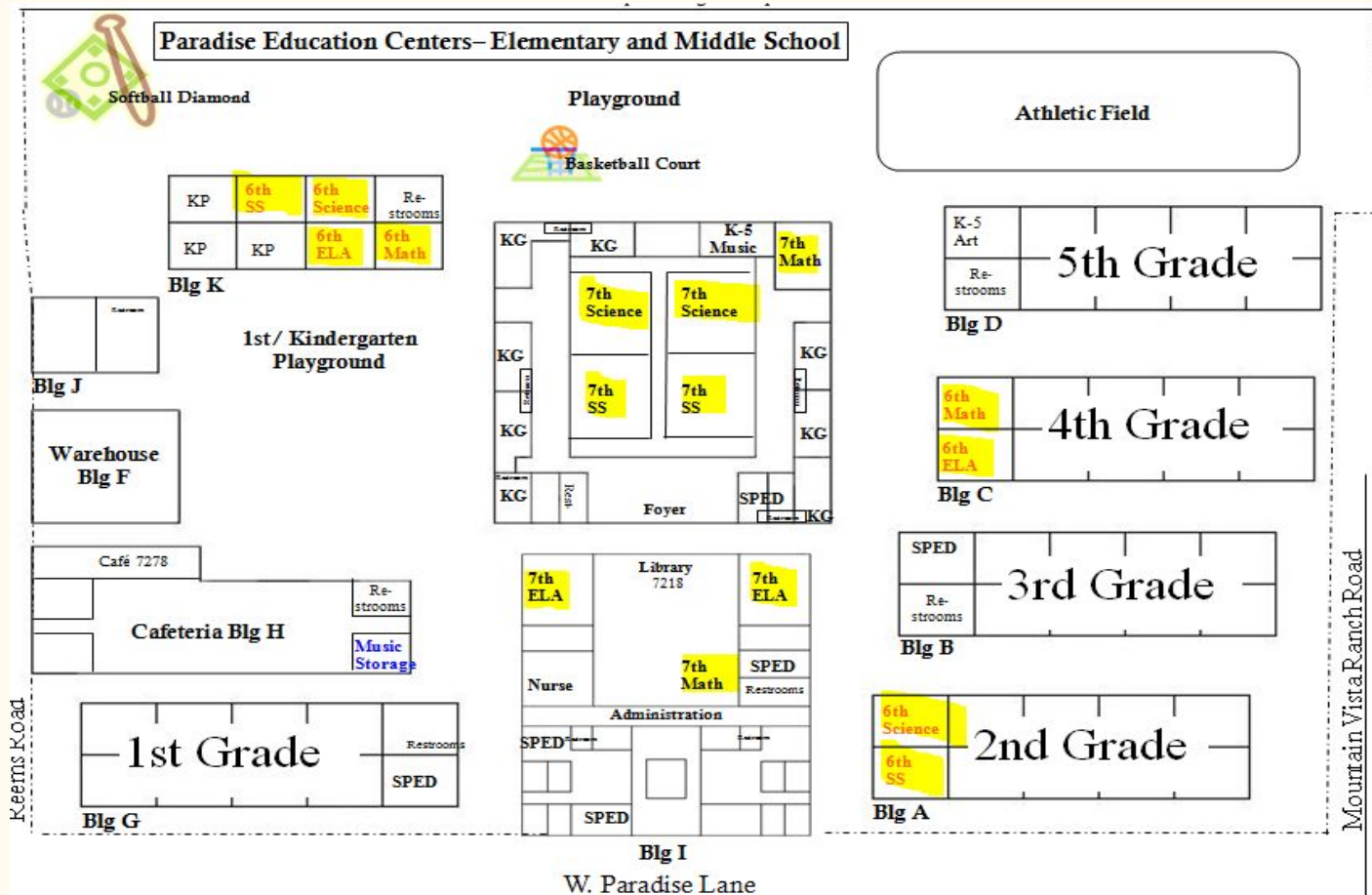
# PHMS on PHHS Campus for First Quarter

# Transportation

## Short Term Scenario:

Parents of 6th & 7th grade students that have siblings in 8th-12th grade will be provided the option of free transportation from PHHS campus for first quarter transition plan. Due to the delay of opening the campus next door to PHHS, this service is provided to 6th and 7th graders with 8th-12th grade sibling that will be dropped off and picked up at the PHHS campus.

# Transportation

Long Term Scenario: \$185 per Semester/\$325 per year

Parents may apply to secure a paid spot on a bus that runs between all three campus. ***IF*** parents will need this spot 2nd quarter or beyond, they must fill out form and pay appropriate fees.

**Please drop off form with payment to PHHS campus. Spots are first come first serve.**

(Note- Parents that do not need the bus 1st QT due to 6th & 7th grade being housed at PEC Campus will have a adjusted rate)

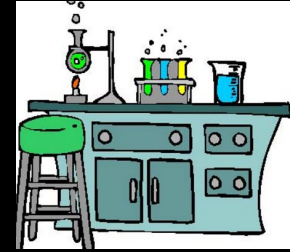
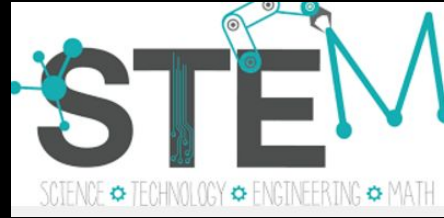
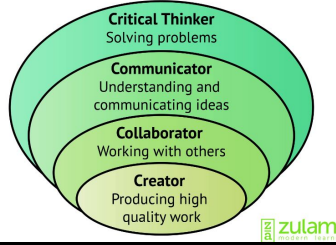
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# Clubs

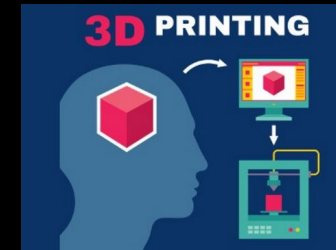
